- Please stop when you reach zero.

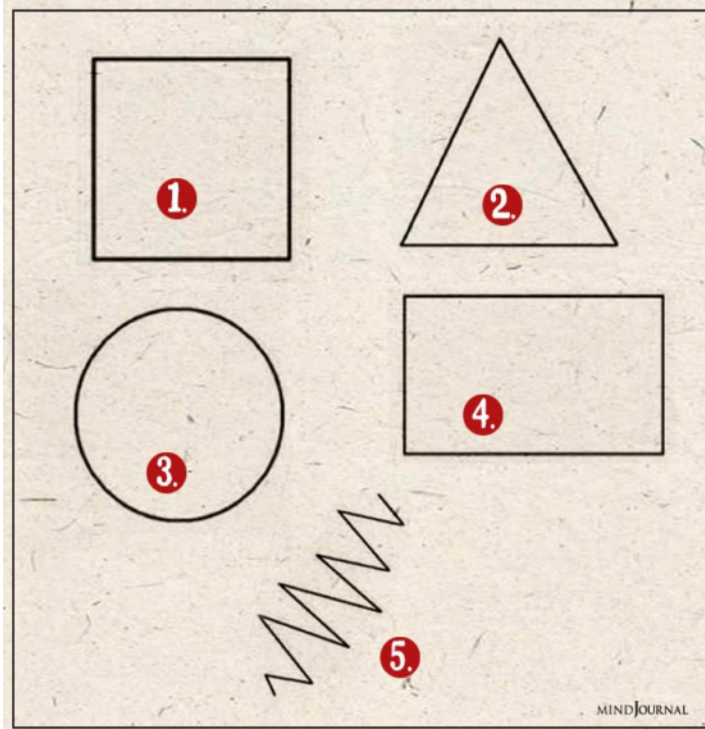
Section 4: Language (10 points)
