Medical History

Summarize relevant medical history, including past diagnoses, surgeries, and chronic conditions.

Current Medications

List all medications the patient is currently taking.

Presenting Complaint

Chief Complaint

The patient's primary reason for seeking medical attention

History of Present Illness

Detailed description of the current symptoms, including onset, duration, severity, exacerbating/relieving factors, and associated symptoms

Physical Examination

Vital Signs

Record the patient's vital signs - blood pressure, pulse, temperature, respiratory rate

General Appearance

Describe the patient's overall appearance, demeanor, and level of distress

Systemic Examination

Document findings from a systematic examination, including cardiovascular, respiratory, gastrointestinal, etc.

Diagnostic Tests

Laboratory Tests

List and interpret results of relevant blood tests, urine tests, etc.

Imaging Studies

Summarize findings from X-rays, CT scans, MRIs, etc.

Specialized Tests

Include results of specific tests relevant to the patient's condition

Differential Diagnosis

List of Potential Diagnoses

Generate a list of potential diagnoses based on patient history, symptoms, and test results

Exclusion/Confirmation Criteria

Specify criteria to confirm or rule out each potential diagnosis

Refinement and Final Diagnosis

Refinement of Differential Diagnosis

Narrow down the list based on additional information or consultations

Treatment Plan

Treatment

Detail the recommended treatment options, including medications, therapies, procedures, or referrals to specialists

Patient Education

Provide the patient with information on their condition, treatment, and follow-up instructions

Follow-Up

Schedule follow-up appointments or tests as needed

Consultations and Collaboration**Specialist Consultations**

Note if any consultations with specialists were sought and their recommendations

Interdisciplinary Collaboration

Document any collaboration with other healthcare providers

Patient Consent and Documentation**Informed Consent**

Confirm that the patient has been informed about the diagnosis and treatment options

Documentation

Ensure thorough documentation of the entire process, including discussions, findings, and recommendations
