Based on my professional evaluation and extensive experience treating the patient, I have determined that the presence of an ESA is crucial for their mental health and overall well-being. According to the Fair Housing Act (FHA), individuals with a disability are entitled to reasonable accommodation to keep an Emotional Support Animal in their residence, even in properties with no-pets policies.
