## Geriatric Depression Scale Scoring

## For the short-form version:

- For questions 1, 5, 7, 11, and 13: YES is equal to 0 points, while NO is equal to 1 point.
- For questions 2-4, 6, 8-10, 12, and 14-15: YES is equal to 1 point, while NO is equal to 0 points.
- The scores need to be added to get the total and final score.

| $\mathbf{0}$ to $\mathbf{5}$ | Normal |
| :---: | :---: |
| $\mathbf{6 +}$ | Suggestive of depression; warrants follow- <br> up assessment |
| $\mathbf{1 0 +}$ | Almost always indicative of depression |

## For the long-form version:

- For questions $\mathbf{1}, \mathbf{5}, \mathbf{7}, 9,15,19,21,27,29-30$ : YES is equal to 0 points, while NO is equal to 1 point.
- For questions 2-4, 6, 8, 10, 11-14, 16-18, 20, 22-25, 26, and 28: YES is equal to 1 point, while NO is equal to 0 points.
- The scores just need to be added up to get the total and final score.

| 0 to 9 | Normal |
| :---: | :---: |
| 10 to 19 | Mild Depressive |
| 20 to 30 | Severe Depressive |
