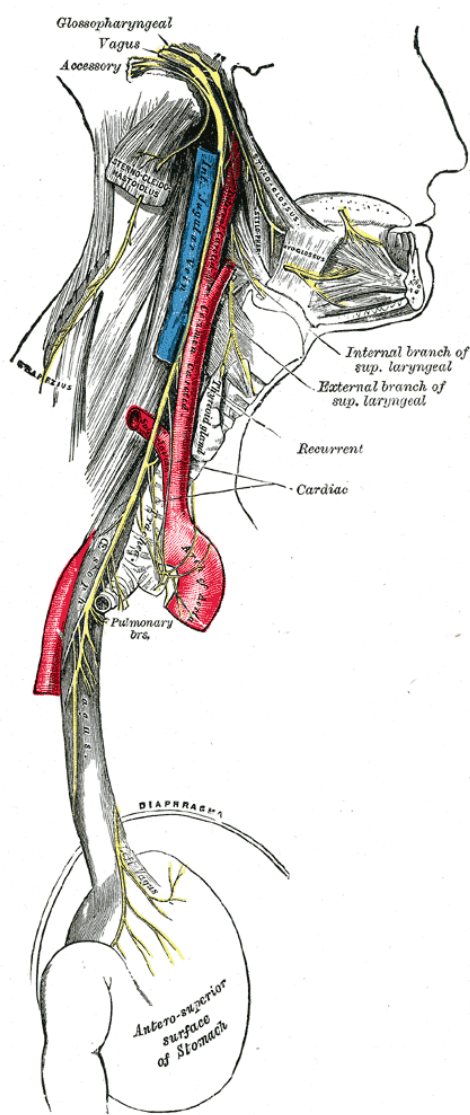

## Glossopharyngeal Nerve Test Procedures:

### Taste Sensation Test:

**Instructions:** Apply different taste solutions (sweet, sour, bitter) to the posterior third of the tongue.
