Calcium score	Interpretation	Risk of myocardial infarction/stroke at 10 years
0	Very low risk	<1%
1 – 100	Low risk	<10%
101 – 400	Moderate risk	10 – 20%
101 – 400 and >75th percentile	Moderately high risk	15 – 20%
>400	High risk	>20%
