## ISS calculation

1. Identify the three most severely injured ISS body regions based on AIS Severity.
2. Square the highest AIS in each of these three regions.
3. ISS = Sum of these three squared values

### Scoring reference

- **Mild:** ISS 1–8
- **Moderate:** ISS 9–15
- **Severe:** ISS 16–24
- **Very severe/critical:** ISS ≥ 25
- **Fatal injury code (AIS = 6):** ISS = 75
