

# Printable List of ICD 10 Codes for Mental Health

The International Classification of Diseases, Tenth Revision (ICD-10) provides a comprehensive classification system for various health conditions, including mental and behavioral disorders. Below is a sample list of some ICD-10 codes related to mental health.

- F09: This category is used when the specific organic or symptomatic mental disorder is not specified or cannot be classified under the other categories.
