### History of Present Illness

45 y/o female, 5 days of worsening cough, green sputum, fever up to 101°F, breathlessness, worse at night. Diabetic, less med/diet compliant since illness onset, no flu shot, no recent travel or known sick contacts.

### Diagnosis

Pneumonia

### Ongoing Medications

Metformin 500mg (for Diabetes)

### Allergies

Penicillin

## Assessment

### Neuro, cardiac, respiratory, GI/GU, Skin

Neuro: Alert and oriented, no signs of confusion

Cardiac: Heart rhythm regular, no murmurs or extra sounds

Respiratory: Increased effort, mild wheezing in lower lobes

GI/GU: Normal bowel sounds, no nausea, last voided 2 hours ago

Skin: Warm, no rashes or lesions, slight pallor

### **Interventions**

#### **Medications Given**

Amoxicillin 500mg at 08:00, Paracetamol 500mg at 09:00  
Salbutamol at 10:00 via nebulizer

#### **Treatments**

Chest physiotherapy at 11:00

### **Plans**

Monitor temperature, reassess in 4 hours, inform doctor if no improvement

### **Additional Notes and Observations**

Slow response to nebulizer, reduced appetite
