

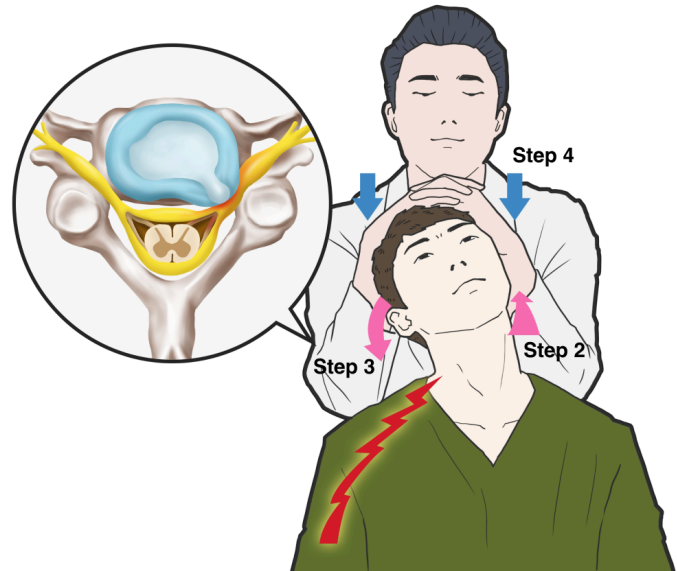
Spurling's Test

Test procedure

1. Seat the patient comfortably in a neutral position and stand behind the patient.
2. Extend the patient's neck.
3. Bend the patient's head laterally toward the affected side.
4. Apply axial compression to the top of the head.



Results and interpretation

- ☐ **Positive result:** The maneuver reproduces radicular pain or other symptoms in the arm corresponding to the affected nerve root.
- ☐ **Negative result:** No pain or symptom is provoked or reproduced.
