My patient has a unique medical history that includes:
chronic migraines and seizure disorder. These conditions first appeared during his military service and have persisted since.

Over the course of our medical interactions, I have carefully reviewed the patient's medical records including the following:
service treatment records and DD214 form. They indicate exposure to traumatic events and head injuries during service.

I am writing to express my professional opinion that the following conditions are directly related to the patient's military service:
chronic migraines and seizure disorder

In my assessment, these conditions are more likely than not associated with the patient's military service. This is based on a thorough evaluation of the available evidence:

- onset of symptoms during service
- a noted increase in frequency and severity following head trauma
- corroborating studies linking similar injuries to these conditions

If these conditions are indeed linked to John Smith's military service, it is my recommendation that they warrant a disability rating of 70%.

In closing, I want to emphasize that my assessment is based on a comprehensive review of John Smith's medical history and service records. I firmly support my patient's claim for disability benefits, and I believe that the evidence strongly supports this.
