Dear VA Medical Center Team,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing on behalf of Sergeant Tom Nook, a veteran who is seeking disability benefits from the Department of Veterans Affairs.

I am a Primary Care Physician at New Horizons Clinic.
I have had the privilege of providing medical care and support to Sergeant Tom Nook.

My patient has a unique medical history that includes:

Chronic lower back pain, PTSD, hearing loss

Over the course of our medical interactions, I have carefully reviewed the patient's medical records including the following:

Service records detailing combat exposure, MRI scans showing lumbar disc degeneration, psychiatric evaluations documenting PTSD symptoms, audiology reports confirming hearing loss, physical therapy notes

I am writing to express my professional opinion that the following conditions are directly related to the patient's military service:

Lumbar disc degeneration, PTSD, bilateral hearing loss

In my assessment, these conditions are more likely than not associated with the patient's military service. This is based on a thorough evaluation of the available evidence:

Service records indicating exposure to combat and loud noise environments
Medical literature linking combat-related stress to PTSD
MRI evidence of service-related physical strain on the lumbar spine
Audiology findings consistent with noise-induced hearing loss in veterans

If these conditions are indeed linked to the military service of Sergeant Tom Nook,
it is my recommendation that they warrant a disability rating of 70%.

In closing, I want to emphasize that my assessment is based on a comprehensive review of medical history and service records. I firmly support my patient's claim for disability benefits, and I believe that the evidence strongly supports this.
